CONDITIONS:

(I) THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS OF PWD VIDE THE CE, WRD, CHENNAI REGION, CHEPAUK, CHENNAI -5. LETTER NO.DB / T5(3) / F- MALAYAMBAKKAM / 2021 / DATED 01.09.2021, ARE TO BE COMPLIED BY THE APPLICANT BEFORE ISSUING OF THE LAYOUT APPROVAL BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY (LOCAL BODY) 1. The existing ground level of the site should be raised to minimum level of (+)23.330m (ie) 2.34m above the sill level of sluice No.7 of Chembarambakkam Tank which is (+)20.990m, with filling varies from 2.14m to 2.21m with layers of not more than 0.30 metre depth to achieve required degree of compaction to the entire area of the applicant land to avoid inundation during the heavy rains. The all-round pavement level within site should not be less than (+)23.330m. 2 The applicant should prepare the layout proposal by considering the suitable internal storm water drainage net work (peripheral & lateral), rainwater harvesting, roads (peripheral & lateral) with road side drain and sewerage treatment plant and its disposal, garbages/debris and other solid waste management disposal as per norms in existence within the applicant land according to the existing rules in force and should get proper approval from the competent authority without fail.

The sewage or any unhygienic drainage (treated or untreated) should not be let into the drain/channel course at any cost and the debris and other materials should not be dumped into the drain/surplus course obstructing free flow of water. The applicant should make drain networks at her own cost and the same is to be connected to the natural storm water drainage or channel.

authorities and PWD/WRD authorities concerned without fail and should not encroach the channel abutting the land. areas in future.

the said course it should be restored to the original standards at his own cost.

6. The channel course in S.No.431 along the boundary of applicant's land should be completely desilted and resectioned by constructing retaining wall on either side as well as bed lining concrete of the drain as per the FMB at the applicant's own cost. The bed level of the above course should be ascertained and restored before commencing the development activity in the presence of the concerned PWD/WRD Executive Engineer. Moreover the width of entire field drain as per Revenue records (FMB) along & within the stretch of applicant's land should be maintained properly without any change and no encroachments.

7. The Government surplus course stretch abutting the applicant boundary in S No 431 should be marked as per FMB and monitored and maintained by the applicant at her own cost. The width of the course should be maintained without encroachments as per Revenue records and the hydraulic parameters of the field drain should be maintained.

The applicant should make necessary periodical arrangements for free flow of water through the existing drain to the downside area within the proposed layout site. Also, the applicant should desilt the drain periodically and remove the obstruction then and there, without any hindrance for free flow of water at her own cost within the proposed land, even after the completion of project also. 8. The applicant should not carry out any other cross masonry structures across the channels without prior permission from PWDWWRD. However if CMDA insist any culvert during development, the applicant should apply to additional culverts for obtaining separate permission from this department.

9 The PWDWRD officers should be allowed to inspect the site at any time during execution and thereafter, if necessary. Advance intimation should be given to the PWD/WRD officers concerned before commencement of work. PWD/WRD is giving opinion only in connection with inundation aspects and does not deliver any rights to the applicant to encroach the PWD / Government Lands.

10. The permission granted to the applicant, should not be altered / modified/ changed to any others. Based on the records submitted by the applicant, the permission is granted. If any documents seem to fake/manipulated/fabricated, in future the above permission will be cancelled without any correspondence. Hence, the applicant is solely responsible of genuinety of the documents submitted.

11. The applicant should abide by the rules and regulation of the PWD/WRD from time to time. The applicant should also abide court of law of both State & Central Government from time to time.

12. The applicant should not object at any time for the maintenance work / improvements work of the channel to be carried out by PWD/WWRD. The applicant should not dump the garbages/debris in the channel and avoid the sewage water into the channel, etc,. The applicant should give an undertaking in writing to the effect that the above proposal will not obstruct in case any maintenance / improvement / development works as per Revenue records [FMB] are to be carried out by PWD/WRD in future periodically.

13. The applicant lands seem to be ryotwari land which would be classified as wet lands are to be converted into residential zone from the agricultural zone by the competent authority. The applicant should get clearance certificate for her site from the Revenue department to make sure that the site is not an encroached property from the water body as well as confirming this proposed site boundaries. 14 PWD/WRD is giving opinion only in connection with the inundation aspect and does not deliver any rights to the applicant to encroach the PWD Government Lands The NOC for this site from the PWD/WRD is purely issued on the basis of inundation point of view.

The owner of the document received from the applicant in respect to the ownership is purely of applicant's responsibility and it is only for reference purpose to this department. The legal validity of this document should be verified by the Development / Revenue authorities. The specific remarks on inundation are purely issued on technical grounds in respect to the physical location of land.
